

Week 17 (Tuesday 5th and Sunday 10th August)

The second and third races of the 4th pursuit racing series were held at Ladies Bay in a pleasant south westerly force three, just gusting into four at times.

A three lap course was set from the beach, with a reach out to a buoy off the Chouet reef, a beat across to a buoy near the end of the Rouse headland, a fast reach down the waves towards the entrance to Ammareurs, and a final run back to the end of channel buoy.

In what were perfect conditions for the light weights, Graham Le Page, off 3 minutes, won the first race, with Ian Campbell (2) holding on to take second, and Rod Hutchinson (3) third.

In the second race Simon Lovell, off 5 minutes, came through strongly on his Serenity board to take first, with Le Page second and Campbell third.

The scheduled Sunday morning course racing was cancelled due to strong winds. Some sailors went short-boarding instead.
