Simon Lovell was the Rabbit but it was Simon Gregory who made best use of the favoured port side of the course and came away with a commanding lead after the first beat which he retained to the finish leaving Simon Lovell in second and Sebastian in third.
Tim Laine retired with a broken extension.

In the second race Simon Lovell took an early lead which he kept until the second beat, where a quick tack by Simon Gregory put him into the lead giving Simon lots of dirty wind! However on the next gybe mark he dropped his sail but made a quick recovery. Going up the final beat Simon Gregory rounded the windward mark first followed by Tim then Simon Lovell.
Simon Lovell took a deeper angle down the run and gibed earlier. It looked as though he had it in the bag as he flapped his way down wind, but Simon and Tim charged up on a fast reach and squeezed through to take first and second place. Stuart who was racing unofficially closely followed in an unrecorded fourth.
