

GBSA Sunday Course Racing 8/8/10
Wind: NW Force 2 to 3. Sunny and warm
Participants: 5

All competitors took to the water on IMCO's. A triangular course was set, with a beat from a buoy just off Ladies Bay, out to a mark near the entrance to Tiger Bay, a very broad reach over to Rouse, then a closer reach back to the start buoy. At the end of the second lap the finish was between the two outermost end-of-channel buoys.

In the first race heavyweight Simon Gregory made full use of his 9.5 metre sail, taking first place from Jo (8.5 m sail), then Graham Le Page was a close third using his 7.4 m IMCO sail.

In the second race lightweight Graham proved that the 7.4 m sail can still be competitive in the right conditions. He established a clear lead by the windward mark in lap 1, which he held through to the finish. Simon was second, with Jo third.

These were the two final races in the third Sunday morning course racing series. The first five in the series were fairly well bunched. Jo was first (10 points), followed by Simon Lovell (12), then Seb (15), Simon Gregory (18) and Graham (20).
